and so we popped back to the rescue for some help. I am pleased to say the help received was fantastic. A treatment plan has been put in place and they will be seeing him once a week for the next couple of months to support his recovery. They are offering this service for free! We would like to raise awareness of this amazing place and ask that if you are thinking of getting guinea pigs as pets, consider visiting the rescue centre in Sealand and rehome some of their animals, instead of visiting a pet shop.
